

Detailed Itinerary

Day 1 – Saturday, August 17 – Arrive in Madrid (D)

If there's one thing you'll notice about madrileños, it's their sociability. Witness it for yourself during our city tour, which includes the Plaza Mayor, the hot gathering spot for locals; the Royal Palace, residence to the King; and El Prado, Spain's repository of artistic treasures. Tonight, join our special Hermes Welcome Dinner.

Day 2 – Sunday, August 18 – Toledo & El Escorial (B)

Venture today to Toledo, city of El Greco. Perched on a dramatic hillside overlooking the Tagus River, Toledo brims with old world charm. You'll visit the ornate cathedral and St. Thomas Church. En route back to Madrid, you'll stop at El Escorial, an historic royal residence and monastery, and the Valley of the Fallen, a monument dedicated to those who died in the Spanish Civil War.

Day 3 – Monday, August 19 – Segovia & Avila (B)

Drive today to Segovia, in the shadow of the Guadarrama Mountains. After a tour of the medieval and mighty Alcazar, overlooking the Eresma and Clamores rivers, continue to Avila, set on a rocky plateau amidst vast Spanish plains. During our visit, you'll tour Spain's first gothic cathedral.

Day 4 – Tuesday, August 20 – Cordoba (B)

Travel by train through spectacular Spanish countryside to Cordoba, and take in this fascinating city during a city tour. Marvel at the Islamic-accented Alcazar of Christian Monarchs, and visit the famed Mezquita mosque-cathedral, with its stunning facades and 856 columns of jasper, onyx, marble, and granite.

Day 5 – Wednesday, August 21 – Granada (B)

Today we'll transfer to Granada, and get acquainted with its sights. The grand highlight today is the hilltop Alhambra Palace. Built by Moors, occupied by Christians, this is where Columbus received blessings for his explorations from Ferdinand and Isabella. You can also stroll the stunning Generalife Gardens, and admire its stunning views.

Day 6 – Thursday, August 22 – Seville (B)

Journey to Seville today, birthplace of the flamenco and Andalucia's artistic and cultural capital. During a city tour, you'll behold its gothic-baroque cathedral and its Giralda, a minaret-turned-bell-tower built with interior ramps to allow its holy men to ascend on horseback.

Day 7 – Friday, August 23 – Jerez de la Frontera (B,L)

Today you'll visit Jerez de la Frontera, world renowned for its production of sherry. Stop at a local sherry cellar for a tasting of the sweet nectar, and enjoy a lunch of regional dishes. The afternoon and evening are free for you to explore Seville on your own.

Day 8 – Saturday, August 24 – Evora, Portugal (B)

Travel to Evora today, where you'll contemplate the eerie Chapel of Bones at the Sao Francisco Cathedral. You'll also visit the imposing Evora Cathedral, perched upon the city's highest spot. We then continue onwards to Lisbon, Portugal's pulsating capital.

Day 9 – Sunday, August 25 – Lisbon (B)

Day 10 – Monday, August 26 – Cabo da Roca & Sintra (B,D)

Continue to Sintra, a UNESCO World Heritage Site for its plentiful 19th-century Romantic architecture. You'll visit its fairy-tale National Palace. GENERAL INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS

LIABILITY AND RESPONSIBILITY: Each guest should carefully read the following conditions. Making a reservation or acceptance of tickets shall be deemed to be consent to the conditions outlined below.

BOOKING CONDITIONS: A deposit of \$500 USD per tour and person is required for us to reserve a space for you. The deposit may be made either with credit card or check. Final payment for the tour is due 80 days prior to departure. Final Payment can only be done by either personal check or credit card, payable to Hermes Tours. If we do not receive final payment by this date we reserve the right to cancel the reservation. Payment in full is required at the time of booking for reservations made less than 80 days before departure date.

CANCELLATION POLICY: All notifications of cancellations much be received in writing. We will assess the following penalties on the day that your cancellation is received: All cancellations will be assessed a \$500.00 USD administration fee per tour/per person. Final payment for the tour is due 80 days prior to departure. If we do not receive final payment by this date we reserve the right to cancel the reservation.

- 1) Cancellations received more than 80 days prior to departure will be assessed a \$500.00 USD administration fee per tour/per person.
 2) Cancellations received within 40-79 days prior to departure will be assessed a cancellation fee of 50% of the total invoice amount.
- 3) Cancellations received from departure date to 39 days prior to departure will be assessed a cancellation fee of 100% of the total invoice amount.
- 4) No refunds will be given for any activity on the tour that you chose not to participate. 5) No travel documents may be issued unless booking has been paid in full.
- 6) Refunds on airline, rail and cruise tickets are subject to the policy of the airline/rail/cruise company.
